

## 第1回 英語リスニング スクリプト

- 1 *Bob* : I want you to come to the party next Sunday, Naoko.  
*Naoko* : Thank you, Bob. What time are you going to start the party?
- 2 *Lisa* : Do you have any brothers or sisters, Yutaka?  
*Yutaka* : Yes. I have a brother and a sister. How about you, Lisa?  
*Lisa* : I have a brother. He plays basketball.  
*Yutaka* : My sister plays soccer. My brother and I play baseball. I have a picture of him and me.  
*Lisa* : Can I see it?  
*Yutaka* : Sure. Here you are.
- 3 Hello, everyone. There are four seasons in Japan. I like summer the best. I swim in the sea every summer. Which season do you like the best? I asked this question last Thursday. There are thirty-seven students in our class. All of you answered the question. Thank you very much.  
I'll tell you about the answers. Look at this graph. Thirteen students answered, "I like summer the best." Spring was more popular than fall. More than ten students answered, "I like winter the best." Thank you.
- 4 *Bob* : I made a cake. Let's eat it together, Misa.  
*Misa* : Wow! I like cake. Do you often make cakes, Bob?  
*Bob* : Yes. I take Japanese cooking lessons from four to six on Wednesdays. After that, I learn how to make cakes.  
*Misa* : Who teaches you?  
*Bob* : My mother's friend, Ms. Sakuma, does. She lives near my house. She teaches how to cook Japanese food from four to six on Mondays and Wednesdays.  
*Misa* : I want to learn how to make cakes.  
*Bob* : Ms. Sakuma is a very good teacher.  
*Misa* : I want to take her lessons, but I must practice tennis on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.  
*Bob* : Ms. Sakuma teaches how to make cakes on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.  
*Misa* : What time does she start to teach on Fridays?  
*Bob* : At four.  
*Misa* : Um .... I can't go. How about Mondays?  
*Bob* : At six.  
*Misa* : OK. I will go on Mondays.
